Provides training to school district employees.</p> <p>●Serenidad Behavioral Health: (956) 568-7105 – Provides evidence-based services for adults, youth, and families with serious mental illness, serious emotional disturbance, or co-occurring disorder who are homeless or at risk of imminent homelessness.</p> <p>●SMART Program: (956) 724-3177 – Provides evidence-based early mental health prevention services to children 0 to 14 years of age and their parents/ caregivers.</p>

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
